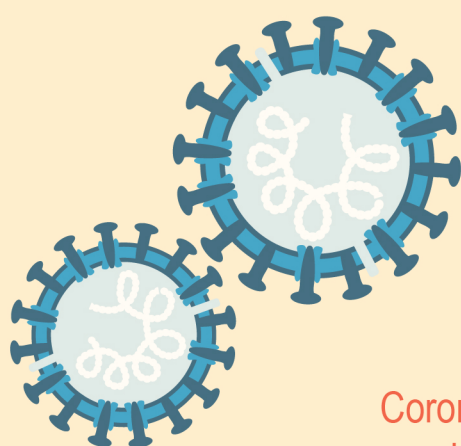




CORONAVIRUS

Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses that cause respiratory illness ranging from the common cold to more severe respiratory diseases like bronchitis or pneumonia. Animal hosts infect humans with the virus. It can then spread from person to person.

COVID-19 originated in December 2019 in Wuhan, China. As of March 2020, the number of confirmed cases globally exceeded **93,000**.

COVID-19 IN NEW YORK STATE

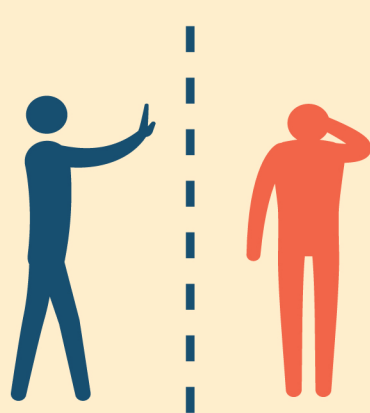
